### Additional Billing Terms:

- There is no fee to enroll for any of our 1-Call Alaska services (Tank, Non-Tank, and NVCC State Coverage)
- We only invoice for your vessel's APC Tank and Non-Tank coverage when they transit through the Alaskan EEZ on a voyage to or from a United States port. Once invoiced, you will not be invoiced for that vessel for any subsequent voyages through the Alaskan EEZ for 365 days from the invoice date. After 365 days, you will be invoiced for that vessel on her next voyage through the Alaskan EEZ to or from a United States port.
- We only invoice you for your vessel's NVCC coverage when they transit through the Alaskan EEZ and enter Alaska state waters (3 nm from shore) within either the Aleutians or Cook Inlet Subarea. Once invoiced, we will not send an invoice for that particular vessel for any other Alaskan port calls for 365 days from the invoice date. After 365 days, you will be invoiced for that vessel on her next Alaska port call or entry within 3 nm of the Alaska shoreline.
