

# **Emergency Response**

By utilizing our owned and maintained assets and leveraging a network of resource partners, our experienced response professionals stand ready to assist every vessel type. # Salvage, Recovery & Environmental Mitigation

We have extensive experience working on complicated projects that require creative planning and execution in compliance with local regulations. When it comes to removing floating or submerged vessels, pollutants from sunken vessels, or remains of offshore structures, our team collaborates, analyzes, simulates, and organizes tactics that complete each job safely, on time, and on budget.

# Compliance

Our commitment to regulatory compliance underpins our reputation in the industry. Since the inception of the OPA 90 Salvage and Marine Firefighting (SMFF) regulations, hundreds of shipowners have entrusted Resolve Marine to provide their vessels with comprehensive response readiness.

- **SMFF.** In the United States and its territories Resolve Marine has the largest inventory of SMFF response equipment and personnel: 23 owned depots and four warehouses.
- Alaska APC. We provide comprehensive oil spill response Alternate Planning Criteria (APC) coverage for vessels transiting Alaskan waters and calling Alaskan ports. Eleven oil spill and three salvage response depots in Alaska are complemented by ocean-going response vessels, owned aircraft, and personnel. We offer complete coast-to-coast compliance: OPA 90 SMFF, Alaska Federal APC Oil Spill Response, and Alaska State Non-Tank Vessel Oil Spill Coverage.
- **China SPRO.** A one-stop solution for Ship Pollution Response (SPRO) coverage across China's extensive coastline with fully stocked warehouses and a network of partners based in major Chinese ports.

From drydock repairs and welding services, to demolition and marine civil works projects, Resolve Marine brings deep technical expertise to every task. Our global response center provides 24-hour vessel monitoring. A naval architecture and marine engineering group conducts sophisticated planning for recovery, salvage, and special projects. ### **OUR STORY**


Founder Joseph Farrell, Jr. began operations in 1980 with the RESOLVE, a single tug that provided salvage services to coastal freighters and small vessels in the Caribbean. In 1984, Joe formed Resolve Marine, as it is known today. In the wake of U.S. Coast Guard OPA 90 regulations, operations expanded: equipment depots were established across North America and a maritime firefighting training facility was launched to train personnel. After refining the emergency response model domestically, the company expanded globally. Joe now leads Mission Resolve, the philanthropic arm of Resolve Marine that focuses on removing plastics and other debris from the world's oceans and other humanitarian, educational, and community efforts.


# **OUR CLIENTS**
